Did you know that 500,000 children with autism will become adults in the next 10 years? 90% of those adults will NOT be able to function independently and will need constant care.

People with developmental disabilities, including autism, will have up to seven times more contacts with police than a member of the general public.

This training is designed to help first responders learn the signs of low to high functioning autism and how to effectively interact with those individuals.

You will walk away with foundational knowledge and a reference guide of tools to assist with safe interactions in emergency situations.

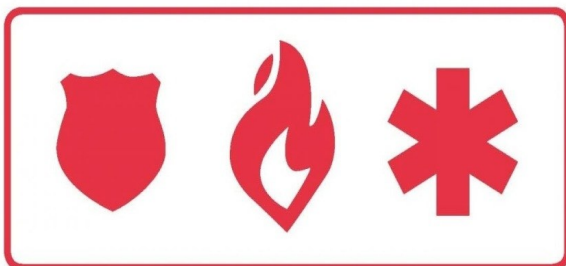
